What does Felix like to do?

Felix likes to get up high on the cupboard.

What does Rosie like to do?

Rosie loves places to hide and has found a perfect box!

Can you draw a place for cats to live?

Children might want to consider drawing a house, room or a comfy bed.

They might also consider drawing a place up high or somewhere that a cat could hide.

How long do cats sleep for every day?

Cats sleep for twice as long as we do.



Can you draw a sleeping cat?

Where do domestic cats (like Felix and Rosie) go to the toilet?

Our domestic cats like a litter tray in a quiet, safe place to go to the toilet.

They also like a clean litter tray!

Where do African wildcats (like Nafisa) go to the toilet?

African wildcats go to the toilet away from their food and water.

They will find a quiet, safe place, away from predators.

Should you wake a sleeping cat?

No! It will scare the cat and that may mean you can be hurt.
